- Provide a brief statement addressing financial need and any relevant circumstances that may impact the applicant's ability to pursue education in aviation
- Highlight any leadership roles, participation in aviation, related clubs or organizations, or relevant extracurricular activities
- Describe any community service or outreach activities related to aviation
- Showcase any innovative projects, research, or initiatives related to aviation
- List any academic, technological, or aviation-related achievements and awards
